ADC Artspace (The Globe) provides 4 arts studios. The tenancy term is two years and ten months commencing from November 2020. HKADC will also provide fitting-out allowance for application to carry out basic fitting-out work. This project is part of the "Space Sharing Scheme for Youth" launched by the government and would not have been made possible without the generous sponsorship of Henderson Land Development Company Limited to lease space at concessionary rate to HKADC and the funding support of the Home Affairs Bureau on the operation costs.
