【Programme Archive】“Meet the Arts Leaders” Series: Mr. Alex Cheung - Curating and Producing Festivals

HKAAA is honoured to have Mr. Alex Cheung, Senior Manager (Festivals) of Leisure and Cultural Services Department, to be our first speaker of the “Meet the Arts Leaders” Series. The talk was successfully held at H6 CONET in November last year.

Alex shared with us the evolution of local arts festivals, and focused particularly on the curating and producing of International Arts Carnival, New Vision Festival and World Cultures Festival.

In the Q&A section, Alex responded to questions in regard to New Vision Festival. Alex stressed that the festival has a unique positioning and should be allowed to have some room to experiment. Festival Office as a part of the government body, that being given relatively rich resources comes a greater responsibility to take risks, to discover performances with great potential to the public, at the same time to support the work of local and international artists.

As a wrap up, Alex suggested three qualities of an outstanding arts administrator - Resilience, Curiosity and Quality Madness.

Hong Kong Arts Development Council (HKADC) now invites qualified **local artists and arts organisations** to submit application for leasing the studios of ADC Artspace (The Globe) located in Lai Chi Kok.

ADC Artspace (The Globe) provides 4 arts studios. The tenancy term is two years and ten months commencing from November 2020. HKADC will also provide fitting-out allowance for application to carry out basic fitting-out work. This project is part of the “Space Sharing Scheme for Youth” launched by the government and would not have been made possible without the generous sponsorship of Henderson Land Development Company Limited to lease space at concessionary rate to HKADC and the funding support of the Home Affairs Bureau on the operation costs.

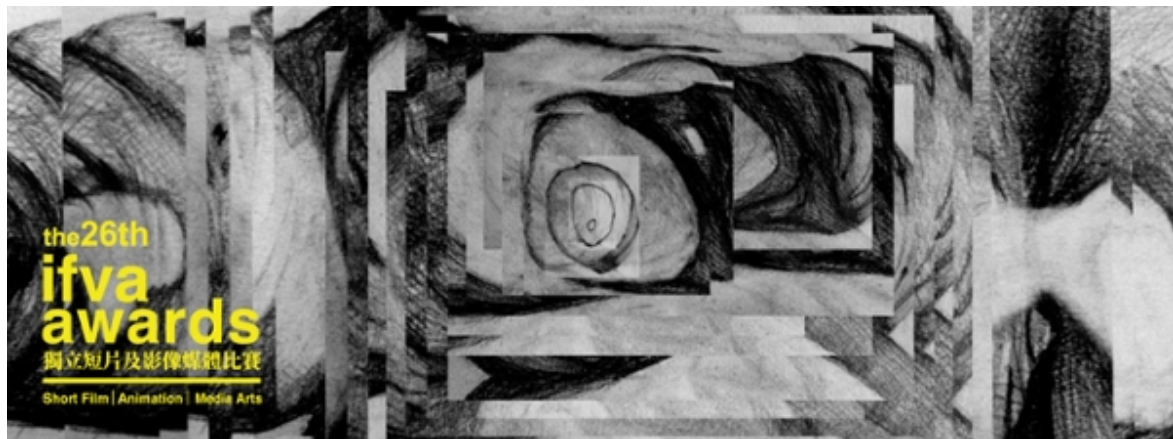
