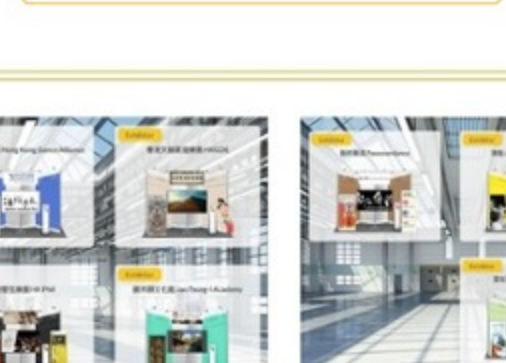
[Highlight Recap] Virtual Career Fair 2021 for Arts and Cultural Industry
