Responsibilities:

Reporting to the Production Manager, the Assistant Production Manager is responsible for:

- 1. Preparing and coordinating technical, production and stage management tasks for international and local programmes;
- 2. Preparing technical budgets and overall production planning;
- 3. Coordinating any required license for indoor and outdoor productions;
- 4. Keeping technical and production equipment and material inventories, ensuring proper inventory listing of all equipment and proper organisation and maintenance of the Festival warehouse;
- 5. Work as technical coordinator for programmes and productions as assigned by the Production Manager.

Qualifications:

- 1. A recognized university/ academy degree in stage/ technical management, lighting design, or equivalent; with minimum 3 years of relevant experience with relevant experience in a supervisory position on performing arts companies, venues or arts organizations; OR
- 2. Proficient in computer software of Microsoft office and AutoCAD;
- 3. Extensive production and technical management experience in different genres of stage productions, including production management and technical operations;
- 4. Excellent spoken and written communication skills in English and Chinese. Proficiency in Putonghua is preferred.
- 5. Knowledge of the NGO/social service sector in Hong Kong
