Trainee Producer (18-month)

Recruited member will be a vital member of the Toolbox Percussion team that is primarily responsible for Leisure and Cultural Services Department-funded programs - **Oi! Spotlight** and assisting the Hong Kong Arts Development Council-funded projects. His / Her main duties will be assisting in program implementation, artist coordination and festival productions, and support any promotional/commercial activities.

The suitable candidate will support us by:

- Assisting in programme development, coordination and arrangement for Company productions, education programmes, sponsor's programmes and any promotional/ commercial activities as assigned by Artistic Director / Creative Producer;
- Assisting the Artistic Director / Creative Producer in negotiation and communication with other presenters and contractors;
- Assisting the Artistic Director / Creative Producer in coordination with personnel of schools and community organizations on the arrangement of education/community projects;
- Preparing all contracts of freelance artists, such as composers, designers, directors, lyricists, playwrights, translators, performers, and tutors, etc., as instructed by the Artistic Director / Creative Producer, and to keep an updated contact list of freelance artists for the company;
- Assisting the Artistic Director and Resident Artists for on-site preparation and coordination;
- Assisting the production team in terms of technical support

We are looking for a passionate arts administrator with the following attributes:

- Bachelor degree or above in Arts Administration/ Cultural Management / Cultural Studies/ or relevant discipline;
- Flexibility and ability to work independently;
- Previous work experience related to event / stage management preferred;
- Demonstration of a strong interest in promoting percussion / contemporary music / performing arts/ theatre and cross-disciplinary productions;
- Self-initiative, proactive, dynamic, and able to meet tight deadlines;
- Good computer skills including proficiency in Microsoft Office, Apple iOS, AutoCAD, and some knowledge of Adobe applications preferred;
- Good interpersonal skills and a team player;



- Good written and communication skills in Chinese, English;
- Hong Kong Permanent Resident aged 18 or above;
- Priority will be given to applicants who were previously enrolled in Toolbox Percussion's Arts Management Internship Programs and partook in other internship opportunities by Toolbox Percussion.

The successful candidate will be offered a 18-month contract, salary offered will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
