The Project Assistant shall assist the Executive & Artistic Director and the Concert Manager in the general administration, marketing needs and technical requirements of the orchestra. Duties include concert planning, stage management, preparing marketing materials, ticketing, merchandise sales, programme research and costume and props handling. A working knowledge of orchestral practices will be required. The candidate must be a good team player, hard-working, reliable, capable of handling stress and capable of working on several projects at a time with detailed precision. Occasional evening and weekend work required.
